



Outside Observation Log

Once completed, this form will fulfill the 6 hours of observation time required by the State of Idaho's Graduated Driver's Licensing (GDL) Program. Start your observation log as soon as possible and observe other drivers on the road. Observe what the drivers are doing wrong so you begin to know how to be a defensive driver in as many situations as possible. Also, pay attention to the defensive maneuvers and actions taken by the person you're riding with, this could help you learn what to do in that situation or what not to do.

DIRECTIONS: Fill in the date you are observing. Record what mistakes were made (passing a stop sign, running a red light, turning into the wrong lane, etc...). Lastly, record the hours and minutes of the entire observation time, for example, if you went on a 10 minute drive to the store and a 10 minute drive back home, that would be 20 minutes of observation.
